



Year Six Graduation Activities Behaviour Agreement

Dear Parents, Guardians & Carers,

We are excited to be planning some fantastic end of primary school celebrations for our students. These include:

- Gumbuya World
- Survivor/Movie Day
- Skate park day with a hot lunch
- Graduation including dinner and disco

We hope to have all students in attendance for these amazing days. In order ensure the safety and wellbeing of all students and staff, we will only be inviting students who have displayed positive behaviours. This means there are some behaviours that will result in a student being ineligible to attend.

Students who display undesirable behaviours at school will receive a strike or depending on the seriousness of the incident, immediate exclusion from an activity. If they receive three strikes they will lose the privilege of attending the first activity. This will then start afresh and the student has three more strikes before missing the next activity.

Strikes will be initiated from the first day of Term Four. This form **MUST** be signed by both student and a parent or guardian and returned or it will be assumed that the student is not attending. Any payment for an activity that a student does not attend as a result of their behaviour, will **NOT** be refunded.

Parents or guardians will receive a phone call when a student's behaviour has resulted in a strike.

We look forward to celebrating the conclusion of Primary School education with our students.

The following are examples of behaviours that will result in a strike:

- Language threatening the safety or wellbeing of others e.g. swearing
- Physical violence
- Not following teachers' instructions/directions
- Leaving a class without permission
- Entering an out of bounds or restricted area without permission

Some behaviours may result in an immediate exclusion from an activity, as decided by the principal. These include:

- Fighting
- Threatening behaviour
- Using an object as a weapon
- Vandalism
- Bullying
